

## Exam Reminders

- This is your definitive exam timetable, make sure you work to this one and not a previous version
- You must know your candidate/exam number this must be recorded on each exam script
- All seat lists will be displayed daily on the notice board in the upper school locker area
- Students with afternoon exams lasting over two hours or those entitled to extra time should be aware that exams may run on later than the end of the school day and arrangements may have to be made for travelling home
- Check your exam timetable daily and be certain to know if the exam is an AM or PM start
- For AM exams you must be lined up in the yard ready to go into the exam room for 9.15am
- For PM exams you must be lined up in the yard ready to go into the exams room for 1.15pm
- Only materials needed for the exams must be brought into the exam rooms, all other belongings must be left in lockers before you line up in the yard
- Students scheduled for more than three hours of exams in one session will receive specific clash instructions, if you are in this situation and have not received instructions when you are due to go on study leave then you must see Mrs Shepherd in room 66A
- Students will not be allowed to leave the exam room until the finish time stated on the notice board in the exam room
- Drinks and food are not allowed in the exam room
- You have already had copies of notices and warnings, these were issued with your previous timetable, they are also on display inside and outside the exam rooms. please make sure you are familiar with them
- Finally remember you are under exam conditions from entering the exam room, you must go straight to your allocated seat and not communicate with anyone else from this time, if you have a question or query you must raise your hand and an invigilator will come to you
